I. FROM ADVERSITY TO INFLUENCE

The Courage of a Survivor: The Foundation of a Heroine

The story of Minister Mary Edwards is not merely one of success, but of profound **Courage** and unwavering resilience. Once dismissively labeled a “Negative Welfare Statistic” at the age of 13, Mary Edwards refused to be defined by her circumstances. She rose to become one of Metropolitan Detroit’s most influential and respected women, embodying the true spirit of a **Survivor**.

Her early life was marked by challenges that would shatter most: childhood abandonment, severe abuse, teen pregnancy, the trauma of domestic violence, struggles with alcoholism, and a heavy family history of mental illness. These harrowing experiences, openly documented in her powerful autobiography, *Born Grown*, were not endpoints but the crucible that forged her character. Mary Edwards masterfully transformed a traumatic youth into a rich and impactful life—a wonderful and enduring legacy.

Building the Joy of Jesus Ministry

In partnership with her late husband, the **Reverend Eddie K. Edwards**, Minister Mary played a pivotal role in establishing the **Joy of Jesus Ministry**. This endeavor grew into a million-dollar organization, a beacon of hope and community transformation in Detroit. Their tireless work and significant civic contributions earned national recognition, culminating in the prestigious **107th Point of Light Award** bestowed by former President George H.W. Bush, Sr. This award stands as a testament to their exceptional dedication to community service.

Mary Edwards’ dedication to upliftment continues today through numerous organizations, specifically focusing her compassion and experience on supporting **widows and youth**, ensuring that the foundational work of the ministry lives on.

II. A JOURNEY OF RADICAL FAITH AND UNWAVERING DEDICATION

The Genesis of a God-Sized Calling

The ministry's roots trace back to 1976 when Evangelist Rosie Curry first encountered Mary, then employed at General Motors. Mary's passion for scripture was immediately evident.

She successfully requested a conference room to host a lunch-hour Bible study, initially led by Rosie. That small gathering soon exploded into a spontaneous revival, spreading "from house to house" in a manner reminiscent of the early church described in Acts 2:41-47.

"Mary is a go-getter for God. If He tells her to do something, she does it with her whole heart," Rosie Curry states. *"What I admire about Mary the most is her **boldness, strength, and courage**... Even though she always introduces me as her 'Mentor,' I have learned many things from Mary. That's how it should be when you birth a child into the world. You want them to be greater than you."*

Integrity in Stewardship and Service

The **Late Reverend (Chaplain) Omie Brooks**, a close associate for 25 years, praised Minister Mary's exemplary character and leadership in the demanding role of ministry administration. *"In the 25 years that I've known Minister Mary Edwards, she has always been a God-fearing and loving person... She has always demonstrated honesty and fairness towards others."*

Chaplain Brooks detailed Mary's indispensable role in managing the significant finances of Joy of Jesus Ministries and successfully securing vital grants—making her *"a great asset to her husband and the ministry."* Following **Rev. Edwards' passing in 2004**, Mary has steadfastly honored their commitment, faithfully carrying on their "wonderful legacy" of service to the Detroit community.

III. THE TRANSFORMATIVE IMPACT OF MENTORSHIP AND COMPASSION

Restoration and Lifelong Guidance

The true measure of Minister Mary's life lies in the individuals she has guided. **Tom Wilson**, who described his life as "a mess" before meeting Mary and Eddie three decades ago, credits the couple with his eventual return to Christ.

"I watched this couple live their ministry. They brought the Joy of Jesus to literally thousands of people," Wilson recalls. He notes that since her husband's passing, Mary has expanded their legacy through crucial initiatives, notably **Widows With Wisdom**. This ministry offers vital support to women navigating the complex grief of losing a spouse. *"Her passion and compassion for service know no bounds,"* he concludes.

The “Home School” of Radical Obedience

Emmese Sommers-Miller offers a deeply personal and moving testimony, recognizing Mary as a rare example of “**radical obedience**” in Christian faith. “*During one of the darkest, dampest (from tears), and most character-defining seasons of my life, she took me into her home (to live) and under her wing (to survive)... Has anyone ever saved your life? What about your testimony? What about your potential to lead? The Holy Spirit used Min. Mary to do this for me.*” This narrative highlights the sacrificial depth of Mary’s commitment to mentorship.

A Legacy Multiplied Through Mentees

The mentorship continued with **Chaplain Anita Clay Griffin**, who became Mary’s mentee later in life while learning the art of writing. Chaplain Griffin previously watched the enduring impact of Joy of Jesus when the ministry mentored her own sons. “*I find her to be quite **compassionate, steadfast, and nurturing** in her approach. I highly recommend Minister Mary for the honor due her,*” she states.

Even at a distance, Mary’s influence is felt. **Sherryl Williams**, “**Ms. Louisiana**,” found crucial support through the **Widows with Wisdom** website following a period of loss and relocation. She described their connection as “truly a divine connection,” demonstrating Mary’s ability to minister across miles.

Belief in Potential	Visualizing and articulating the possibilities for the learner’s spiritual, professional, and personal life.
Vulnerability and Transparency	Openly sharing successes, strengths, weaknesses, failures, and life lessons, fostering trust.
Honest Yet Affirming Confrontation	Addressing faults and errors with integrity while consistently affirming the individual’s worth.
Standing By Through Trials	Committing to unwavering support through both self-inflicted and external life crises.
Goal Setting and Dream Support	Actively assisting the learner in setting and pursuing goals for their spiritual life, career, or ministry.
Objective Evaluation	A willingness to honestly and objectively evaluate progress and areas for improvement.
Living the Teaching	Faithfully living out every principle and lesson she teaches, providing a genuine model of life.

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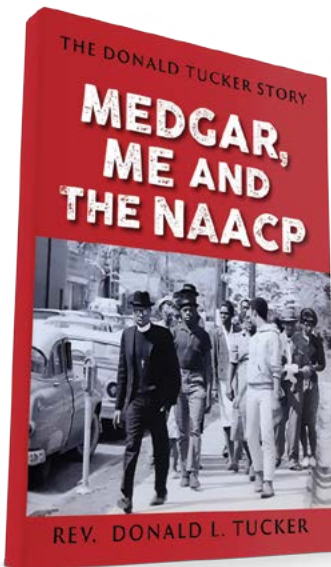


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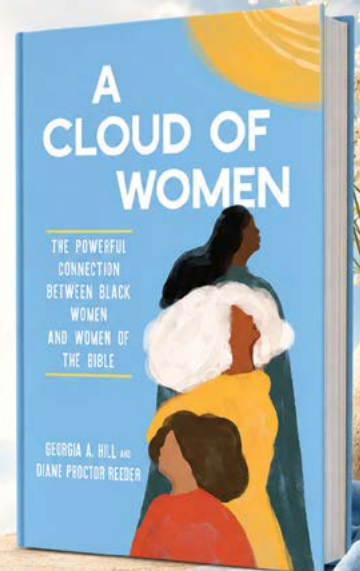
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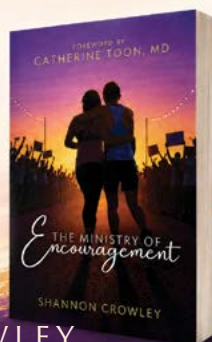
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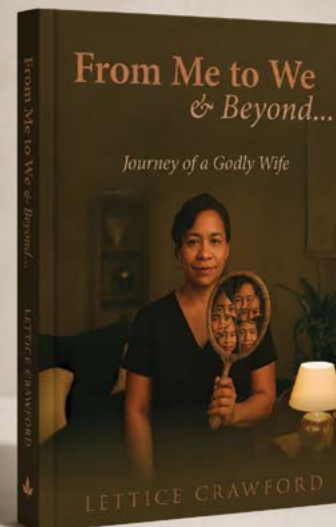
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THE IMPORTANCE OF LEAVING A LEGACY



“If you want to run fast, run alone. If you want to run far, run with a team and you will have someone to pass the baton to.”

A legacy can be many things. It can be a good name, which the Bible says is better than silver and gold (Proverbs 22:1). It can be a family recipe. It can be a bell, which is what Paul Bridgewater, CEO of the DAAA, says his grandmother left his father. His father passed the bell down to him and one day he will pass it down to someone in his family. A legacy can also be an autobiography, a memoir, letter, medal, or even a picture album. I have an acronym for legacy = **Leaving Every Generation a Chronicle of You**. Let me give you a personal example.

When she was only eight years old, her first of three books was personally presented to First Lady Michelle Obama. Mrs. Obama promised to share it with her husband and her girls.

To this end, I have also written my autobiography, “*Born Grown*,” and another book about the life of my late husband, Rev. Eddie K. Edwards. It contains 52 tributes in his memory. The book is called, “*We Remember*.” Upon his death in 2004, I began to see the importance of leaving a legacy and have continued to do so to this day. Our works are currently available in the University of Michigan Legacy Library in Ann Arbor, Michigan. They can be viewed on-line or by visiting the library.

We will all leave a legacy, whether it is good or bad. What do you want to leave behind? Let me help you write your legacy. Contact me today and let’s get started.

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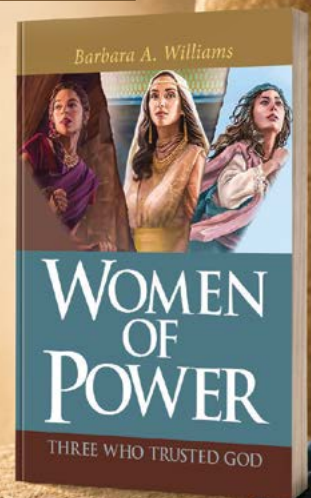
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
